- Women's Leadership Development



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
## Sourcing Plan

The WIT program implemented by a Mission-issued five (5) year (2013 – 2018) Indefinite Quantities Contract (IQC) against which Task Orders may be issued for performance up to one year past IQC expiration date.



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## **Indefinite Quantity Contracts (IQCs)**

- The IQCs are contracts that allow the award of contracts to those contactors that are awarded the IQC for future work. No projects are being awarded as part of the IQC awards. Actual projects will be awarded later through Task Orders as needed.
- IQC holders will be eligible to compete for specific Task Orders (TO's).
- Each TO can be awarded much quicker under an IQC because all of the basic clauses and rates have been negotiated.
